## Los Angeles Democrats,

I am running for Chair of the Progressive Caucus of the California Democratic Party. On Tuesday, March 10, I will be seeking the endorsement of you and the LACDP Central Committee. Let me tell you why.

Progressive Policy: I have worked with many of you over the last four years on issues of importance to Progressives across the country. We have had some successes like the Net Neutrality resolution that I brought forward in 2007.
