Our SCV Clean Money for Better Government Committee that was so active during the Prop 89 campaign is re-organizing to bring information and education to Santa Clarita about the upcoming "Fair Elections" proposition. The bill was signed by Governor Schwarzenegger last year and will be on the June, 2010 ballot. If passed, Fair Elections will create a pilot program that will allow anyone running for the Secretary of State's seat to run using only public money.
