In January SCOPE members voted to support the "Label Genetically Modified (GM) Foods" Initiative as one of our goals for 2012. This petition drive will place an initiative on the June ballot that requires genetically modified foods to be labeled so that consumers know what they are buying. Similar to milk labeling that allows consumers to choose to buy milk from cows free of growth hormones and antibiotics, the initiative would merely give shoppers information about how their food is produced.

"The Future of Food" (www.thefutureoffood.com) is an American documentary film that takes an



in-depth look into unlabelled, patented, genetically engineered foods that have made their way into grocery stores in the United States for more than a decade. Farmers voice their opinions in disagreement with the food industry, detailing the impacts on their lives and livelihoods from this new technology. The film also shines a light on the market and political forces that are changing what people eat.
