Come mix and mingle with visual, performance and literary arts professionals from Afghanistan, Angola, Argentina, Australia, Cameroon, Croatia, Estonia, Ghana, Haiti, India, Iraq, Jordan, Malawi, Morocco, Palestinian Territories, Peru, Sierra Leone, Slovak Republic, Sudan, Turkey, Ukraine and Uzbekistanwho have been invited to the U.S. to explore the arts as a platform for social change and multi-cultural understanding.

The 18th Street Arts Center has extended the fascinating exhibition *Perpetual Peace* especially for this reception. This will be your last chance to view this stunning exhibit.

Perpetual Peace was produced over a four-year period (2008-12) during which the artist, Michelle Dizon, traveled throughout the Philippines researching sites impacted by neocolonial and neoliberal policy. Dizon documented



subjects which included the ruins of former US military bases, the extraction of natural resources by multinational corporations, the development projects of USAID, the conflict zones of the southern Philippine island of Mindanao, and the camps for those displaced by war and disaster.
