Ten months after the earthquake in Haiti, what progress has been made? **Kathryn Adams** Ed. D. has been volunteering with a mental health team in Haiti and will share observations of the conditions on the ground—economic, environmental, political, societal, psychological, and physical. She will also discuss emerging grassroots initiated development projects that foster leadership rather than dependence, using as an example efforts to bring about universal education. The challenges facing Haiti ten-months after the earthquake started months and years before that single event, and the causes of those challenges are tied to the widening stratification between the rich minority and the poor majority internationally.
