

- Public, Private, and Non-profit Employers are highly encouraged to participate
- Fill your entry level positions
- We pre-screen candidates

- Up to 100% of wage cost can be covered, the employer must supervise the employee
- Federal funds (other than CalWORKs) can not be used to pay supervision or any remaining wage costs

- Work assignments up to 12 months
- Gain a valuable employee
- On-the-Job Subsidized Employment Training (OJT) is also available
- Employers receive reimbursement for OJT wages paid



Los Angeles County in partnership with the South Bay Workforce Investment Board (SBWIB) provides you with employees funded by the **Federal Stimulus Package**. This program begins May 2009 and ends in September 2010. Employees can be hired directly by SBWIB. All participating employers will be required to enter into an agreement with SBWIB. SBWIB is the employer of record, performing payroll functions and absorbing the Workers Compensation liability.
