Call for Facilitators

AmericaSpeaks is seeking 115 facilitators for the **National Town Hall Meeting of Advancing Futures for Adults with Autism** on **November 13, 2009**.

This Town Hall will bring together over 1,000 caregivers, advocates, elected officials, family members, and adults with autism for a full day program in 16 cities across the nation. Chicago is the central location of 400 participants requiring 40 Table Facilitators. Satellite locations with 50 participants require only 5 Table Facilitators per site.

This program seeks to raise awareness and build momentum to support a national policy agenda for addressing the needs of adults with autism.

Volunteer table facilitators will work with small groups of 8-10 people to deliberate around questions and issues related to the Autistic community nationwide. The agenda, discussion questions, and timeline will be determined in advance. A Lead Facilitator will guide participants and Table Facilitators from one exercise to the next. Facilitators are expected to have experience with small group face-to-face deliberation, comfort with diversity and difference of opinion. Prior to the Town Hall facilitators will be oriented to the agenda and subject-matter.
