- A. Learns driving techniques of dump trucks and articulating equipment in a construction field application. Learns proper applications of controls, valves, and gauges. Learns grade stake identifiers and vehicle right of ways. Learns proper inspection and maintenance practices and can perform minor repairs. Must possess excellent communication skills.
- B. Learns hoisting techniques, hold in place and float procedures. Learns proper gear selections, over speeds, and downhill braking methods.
- C. Will learn proper safety procedures for the safe handling and driving of equipment. Learn to understand signals and awareness of the operating environment.

Fuel Truck Driver

- A. Learn preventative maintenance standards of off road machinery. Perform fuel applications for equipment. Learn to drive numerous types of equipment that is commonplace in the construction environment.
- B. Learn proper techniques for liquid storage of products associated with the environment and perform inventory controls of parts and liquids. Establish excellent communication skills with field and office personal.
- C. Will learn proper safety procedures for the safe handling and driving of all construction equipment. Will learn proper movement techniques when working around equipment and construction personal.

Low Bed Driver 5 Axles or More

- A. Learns driving techniques in operating heavy equipment in the construction environment. Learn procedures in loading and off loading of heavy equipment. Learns all rules and regulations pertaining to highway transportation of oversized cargo.
